1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Eshman at 5:15pm.

2. **Comments from the Public**

Phyllis Shafran asked why the URA paid for WiFi in Ketchum. Commissioner Randy Hall said the URA considered it a legitimate economic development driver. The hardware was donated from Motorola and Microsoft, and Allen & Company donated \$100,000 for operations. The management fee has been the same for a couple years. The URA will take a new look at WiFi in a couple months to see if should just be a hot spot in Town Square, or improved to a higher speed. 20% of the users use 80% of the bandwidth, so the URA is considering charging for the service.

3. **Consent Calendar**

Approval of minutes from the March 15, 2012 URA Board meeting

Commissioner Nina Jonas made a couple corrections to the minutes.

Recommendation to approve current bills.

Executive Director Gary Marks said the URA will be about \$300,000 of the \$400,000 fund balance goal by the end of the current fiscal year.

Commissioner Nina Jonas asked why there was a general attorney's fee and an Urban Renewal Agency fee.


Commissioner Trina Peters moved to approve the Consent Calendar, with amended minutes. Motion seconded by Commissioner Randy Hall, and passed unanimously.
