

RESOLUTION NUMBER 13-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, TO EXPRESS SUPPORT FOR THE WOOD RIVER TRAIL MAINTENANCE, SIGNIFICANT AND RESURFACING PROJECTS AND PROPOSED LEVY FOR SUCH MAINTENANCE AND EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, The City has historically supported the Blaine County Recreation District and its creation of the Wood River Trail multi-use path; and

WHEREAS, the trail serves an estimated 300,000 visits per year; and,

WHEREAS, the trail is in need of significant resurfacing and rehabilitation.


