JOB SUMMARY

Operates heavy-duty equipment and perform misc labor duties safely under the supervision of the Supervisor or Department Superintendent for the construction, repair or maintenance of city streets, alleys and storm sewers.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Essential

- Operates various types of heavy-duty equipment (i.e., truck, front end loader, back hoe, sweeper, sander, etc.).
- Assists in laborer duties (i.e., road and other patching using asphalt and cement, etc.).
- Maintains traffic signs by placing, replacing, deciding where the sign should go, etc.
- Coordinates with departments where maintenance and repair needed by attending meetings, etc.
- Performs preventative maintenance by greasing, oiling, etc. on equipment.
- Performs after hours “on call” duties for snow removal operations.
- Available to respond to snow removal requests when needed.

Additional

- Performs other duties as assigned or needed.

QUALIFICATIONS

Essential

- Three (3) years experience in the safe operation of heavy motorized equipment.
- Physically and mentally perform the duties listed above (i.e., bending, stooping, reaching, pushing, pulling, climbing, running, walking, standing, kneeling, crawling, lifting up to 50 lbs., 50% of the time overall, grasping, seeing, communicating, etc.).
- Outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Ability to communicate well with the public and crew.
- Vibration and noise is present in the work conditions.
- Ability to perform essential duties efficiently and accurately with or without reasonable accommodations and without endangering incumbent or other employees.
- Valid Idaho Drivers License.

Additional

- Ability to perform strenuous manual labor (i.e.; lifting 75lbs., shoveling etc).
